**Rules:**

1. Exhibitor and animal must be present for judging. Only one pocket pet per exhibitor.
2. Exhibit will consist of a judge interview about the animal being exhibited at time of judging. Animals to be released after class concludes.
3. Pocket pets must be kept in a secured cage and removed only when asked by the judge.
4. No dogs or rabbits are allowed. Guinea pigs, chinchillas, snakes, geckoes, and all other small pets not otherwise stated and not prohibited by law are welcome.
5. Class welcome to all exhibitors ages 5 - 19.
6. Read and comply with Livestock Rules, General Rules & Policies, IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics, and MDA Health Requirements for Livestock.

Premium for class 001 is: A - \$3.00 B - \$2.00 C - \$1.00

Trophy awarded to best Pocket Pet at Judges discretion.

- Rules:
1. Dog need not be of purebred stock, but must be at least 6 months of age.
  2. Current Rabies Certificate must be presented at time of check-in. It is recommended that all dogs be vaccinated for DHLPP/Parvo, Bordetella and Corona Virus.
  3. Exhibitors are limited to showing 2 dogs.
  4. Exhibitor may only show one dog per obedience class.
  5. Dogs must be on leash at all times when not exhibiting. No dogs are to be unattended unless crated.
  6. No aggressive dogs allowed. They will be asked to leave the show ground; this will result in a forfeiture of all premiums.
  7. All dogs must be breed appropriately groomed prior to entry of judging area.
  8. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs!
  9. You must have 3 qualifying scores before moving up to the next higher class level, or equivalent achievement in another sanctioned organization.
  10. Exhibitors must get a total Obedience score of 50% of each exercise and a minimum score of 170 points out of a possible 200 points, with no less than 50% in any one exercise. Exhibitors must get a minimum Agility score of 85 points to qualify. Exhibitors must get a minimum of score in Rally of 70 points out of 100 possible points to qualify.
  11. Females in season will not be allowed to show at the event. Contact superintendent.

  13. Read and comply with General Rules & Policies, and IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics.
  14. Exhibitors and dogs must have had previous experience in Agility to register for this class, and be familiar with the equipment to enter this division.
  15. Dogs are only allowed in designated areas.

**Division 1 SHOWMANSHIP**

- 001 Sprouts 5-7 years
- 002 Junior A, 8-11, exhibitor beginning or having one previous year of showmanship experience in any venue.
- 003 Junior B, 8-11, exhibitor beginning their third or more years of showmanship experience in any venue.
- 004 Intermediate A, 12-14, exhibitor beginning or having one previous year of showmanship experience in any venue.
- 005 Intermediate B, 12-14, beginning their third or more years of showmanship experience in any venue.
- 006 Senior A, 15-19, exhibitor beginning or having one previous year of showmanship experience in any venue.
- 007 Senior B, 15-19, exhibitor beginning their third or more years of showmanship experience in any venue.

**Division 2 DOG OBEDIENCE**

- 008 Pre-Novice A, new exhibitor, new dog, on lead
- 009 Pre-Novice B, experienced exhibitor and/or experienced dog, on lead
- 010 Novice A, new exhibitor in this class, new dog in this class
- 011 Novice B, experienced exhibitor and/or experienced dog
- 012 Graduate Novice, all exhibitors
- 013 Open, A or B, all exhibitors

**Division 3 RALLY**

- 014 Novice A, new exhibitor, new dog, on lead
- 015 Novice B, experienced exhibitor and/or experienced dog, on lead
- 016 Intermediate A, new exhibitor in this class, new dog in this class, on lead
- 017 Intermediate B, experienced exhibitor and/or experienced dog, on lead
- 018 Advanced A, new exhibitor in this class, new dog in this class, off lead
- 019 Advanced B, experienced exhibitor and/or experienced dog, off lead

**Division 4 AGILITY**

- 020 Beginner A, new exhibitor, new dog, on lead, exhibitor may jump the jumps with the dog
- 021 Beginner B, experienced exhibitor and/or experienced dog, on lead, exhibitor may jump the jumps with the dog
- 022 Intermediate A, new exhibitor, new dog, off lead, exhibitor will not be permitted to jump the jumps with the dog
- 023 Intermediate B, experienced exhibitor and/or experienced dog, off lead, exhibitor will not be permitted to jump the jumps with the dog
