- **Human Interest** – depicts event or activity, (e.g. Halloween, ball game, ect.)
- **Landscape** – a picture representing a view of natural scenery – may include seascapes or snowscapes, lunar, sun shots, etc.
- **Nature** – spiders, cocoon, nests, bees, butterflies, reptiles, bugs, etc.
- **Portrait** – representation of a person(s) usually showing the face & shoulders, a posed picture without activity or distracting scenery
- **Still Life** – a photo consisting primarily of inanimate objects, (e.g. a vase of flowers, a bowl of fruit, etc.)
