Rules

1. **AT TIME OF PRE-ENTRY FOR CLASSES** exhibitor is to provide a copy (on paper or emailed) of their proof of negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) Test results, Test must have been within the past twelve months. At time of entry on grounds, presubmitted coggins will be matched to horse (per State Law requirements).
2. Each class is 25 cents.
3. Age as of January 1st of the current year.
4. Sprouts (ages 5-7) are to show in sprout classes only. 5-6 year olds MUST be on a leadline. 5 year olds can only lead horses.
5. **No entries accepted after Fair pre-registration deadline in July.**
6. Horses will be ridden in exhibit and practice areas only, with rider using helmet at all times. Anyone riding in non-designated areas will be asked to leave the fair.
7. Stalls will have water available at all times and cleaned by 9 am each day. Violation of rule may require removal of horse from the fair.
8. Horse trailer will be parked in designated areas only. A limited number of stalls in the Open Horse Barn and Posse barn are available for a \$20 deposit. Deposit will be returned if stall is completely cleaned at the end of the week. Tack stalls will be distributed by Fair Superintendent one week prior to show and posted in the Open Horse Barn and Posse barn. No staples will be allowed to be used on stalls. Please hang or tape informational posters or decorations for Class 1646 and 1647 and hang/attach entry tag on stall to door handle.
9. Classes which have 5 or less entrants may be combined.
10. 4Genesee County Fair are not responsible for damage, theft, or care of property or animals while on show grounds.
11. Horses shall not be around livestock exhibits, use only wash stand by Open Horse Barn.
12. To participate in High Point the appropriate class number must appear on entry form. Points to be awarded are as follows: 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 (regardless of class size). Tie determined by highest number of first places.
13. Walk Trot shall only show in Walk Trot Classes. Canter in a total of three strides or more in a Walk Trot speed class will result in class disqualification. Walk Trot Canter riders ONLY show in W/T/C classes.
14. Read & comply with General Rules & Policies, IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics, MDA Health Requirements.
