The Genesee County Fair offers Camping privileges to its exhibitors and/or superintendents.

Campsite location and campers' names are posted at the Fair Office 3 days prior to the opening day of the Fair.

Camping Permits will be issued by the Office upon arrival.

Rules

1. Campsites shall be issued to superintendents, directors, and exhibitors.
2. Vehicles shall not be in Camping Area. All vehicles shall be parked in a designated Parking Lot, contiguous to the Camping Area.
3. Camping Permits shall include one parking pass, which allows admission of vehicle and driver for the week (does not include Grandstand Entertainment).
4. **Available in the southwest corner is a dump station for waste. Please tidy up after using.**
5. Curfew hours shall be enforced – 12 Midnight to 5:00 a.m. This means that no campsite shall have any disturbance during curfew hours.
6. **During curfew hours, Campsites shall be chaperoned by a parent or legal guardian at least 21 years of age.**
7. No changing of campsites except by permission of the Camping Director.
8. **Camping is primitive!** Limited electricity is available on first come first served basis with superintendents and fair officials given priority. **NO** water hookups allowed. Absolutely **NO** air conditioners, generators or electric roasters.
9. Campers shall bring their own picnic table.
10. Campers shall be equipped with a fully operational A:B:C rated fire extinguisher.
11. Campfires shall be permitted ONLY in an authorized burning container; at least 12" off the ground with screened lid; a five gallon bucket of water and fire extinguisher shall be within 10' of the campfire; Camping Code Enforcer shall have final say on what shall be permitted.
12. Livestock trailer parking shall be next to camping boundary, perpendicular to the south-side of the Livestock Arena wash-rack.
13. Dogs shall be allowed on the fairgrounds only while in the immediate control of a competent person and while on a leash of less than six feet in length. Except for Leader Dogs, dogs shall not be allowed in the Grandstand Arena, Midway, or Beer Tent. Dogs shall not be allowed within 50 feet of any live animal exhibit or exhibit area.
14. Please leave your campsite as clean as you found it.
15. Camping permits are purchased in advance by completing sheet and submitting it with your entry form, entry fees, and camping fee. Campsites will be assigned only after all information has been given.
16. **CAMPING REQUESTS WILL NOT BE ISSUED AFTER Friday, July 6TH.**
17. Management reserves the right to withhold any and all premium monies from any exhibitor who participates directly or indirectly in an act of disturbance or destruction to other individuals and/or their property. Management reserves the right to prosecute to the fullest extent of the law. Individuals found in violation of the aforementioned will be held financially responsible for all damages incurred under said violation.
18. **Breaking of any camping rules shall result in removal from the facility, without refund.**
19. **No intoxicating beverage shall be possessed or consumed within the EA Cummings Center other than within the duly licensed Beer Tent.**
