Rules

- At time of entry, exhibitor must provide proof of negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) Test results for all horses over six months of age (must be sent in with entry form); test must have been conducted within the past twelve months. Exhibitors entering the day of the show must provide proof at check-in, before unloading.
- ANY age exhibitor may show in the open horse classes, except where specific age classes are established. Age is as of January 1, of this year.
- Entries are limited to 1 exhibit per class (one horse/one rider). The same horse cannot ride twice in the same event.
- Best of Show is on one horse/one rider combination.
- Horses may be ridden in the exhibit and makeup rings ONLY.
- Ponies may only enter in pony classes. Ponies shall be 56 inches & under.
- ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per exhibitor plus \$5.00--per class by Friday, July 7th. Late Entries will be accepted at \$10.00 per exhibitor plus \$10.00 per class. Best of Show Class Entry Fee is \$1.00.
- A limited quantity of stalls are available: \$15.00 for Sunday, or \$25 for Saturday and Sunday. Please call the Fair Office for more information.
- All exhibitors must bring their Exhibitor Confirmation Form day of show.
- Horses name must be on the entry form.
- Please use a separate entry form for each horse and rider combination.
- High Point will be posted outside Office on the following day, or notified.
- Points to be awarded are as follows: 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1; as long as class has minimum of 6. Example: If 5 in a class, points would be 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. In the event of a tie, the High Point will be determined by the exhibitor with the most first placings.
- Show will be held in the Exhibition Arena. Please Park in the Staging Area to the South of the Arena.
- Read and comply with General Rules & Policies, IAFF National Code of Show Ring Ethics, and MDA Health Requirements for Livestock.

Rules

- At time of entry, exhibitor must provide proof of negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) Test results for all horses over six months of age (must be sent in with entry form); test must have been conducted within the past twelve months. Exhibitors entering the day of the show must provide proof at check-in, before unloading.
- Dress: Western attire properly worn (Boots, Long Pants, Western Belt, and Western Saddle.)
- ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per exhibitor plus \$5.00--per class by Friday, July 6th Late Entries will be accepted at \$10.00 per exhibitor plus \$10.00 per class.. Best of Show Class Entry Fee is \$1.00.
- A limited quantity of stalls are available: \$15.00 for Sunday, or \$25 for Saturday night and Sunday.
- All horses must be under control at all times.
- May ride more than one horse in the same class.
- In timed events, limited humane use of bats is allowable. A rider may use a bat behind the cinch. A rider may use the flat of the hand while running patterns, but not to assist in turns. No buzzers or electrical devices allowed. All bats must have poppers. Spurring to be done behind the front cinch, no excessive spurring. Disqualification at steward's discretion.
- All exhibitors must bring Exhibitor Confirmation Form day of show.
- Horses name must be on the entry form.
- Changes and additions must take place prior to start of previous show.
- Horse & Rider cannot break pattern. Horse and rider must maintain forward motion.
- Poles, Kegs, & Barrels: 1.) Can touch pole/barrel; 2.) Jumping keg is breaking pattern/5 second penalty.
- Rescue man must make contact with the horse behind the marker line and must be mounted properly when the Timer line is crossed.
- Please use a separate entry form for each horse and rider combination.
- High Point will be posted outside Office on the following day, or notified.
- Points to be awarded are as follows: 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1; as long as class has minimum of 6. Example: If 5 in a class, points would be 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. In the event of a tie, the High Point will be determined by the exhibitor with the most first placings.
- Show will be held in the Exhibition Ring (South of Open Pole Barn). Please park to the East of the Ring.
