PURPOSE OF THE GENESEE COUNTY FAIR

The purpose of the Genesee County Fair is to provide a chance for youth and adults to come together and celebrate our counties rich and varied cultural traditions, as well as to share in memories that will last a lifetime.

JUDGING PROCESS

The Genesee County Fair Queen Pageant judging system is designed to promote diversity, individuality and overall achievement among all contestants. Judges score the individual contestants immediately following each phase of the Pageant. Contestants are scored on a point scale, in whole numbers, within each category.

During the Pageant, the weighing of scores awarded per category is distributed as follows:

Application:	1-10 points
Scholastic Achievement:	1-10 points
Interview:	1-20 points
Talent:	1-10 points
Impromptu Question:	1-20 points
Personality:	1-15 points
Poise and Appearance:	1-15 points
TOTAL POSSIBLE:	100 POINTS

Each contestant has to submit an application, which must be typed. Directions must be followed and each question on the application should have a clear answer. Criteria used for scoring the application: appearance and directions followed.

SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENT 1-10 points

Each contestant has to submit an application. Criteria used for scoring the scholastic achievement: one's service to church, school and community.

INTERVIEW – 5 minutes 1-20 points

The panel of judges will meet in a group with each contestant for a 5 minute interview. Questions during the interview come from the contestant's application. Criteria used for scoring the interview: overall first impression, intelligence, vocabulary/grammar, composure and responses to questions asked. Contestants should wear business attire suitable for a professional job interview.

TALENT - 3 to 5 minute 1-10 points

Each contestant will perform a 3 to 5 minute talent presentation. Talent may include, but is not limited to, vocals in every medium, dance in all forms, gymnastics, instrumentals and drama or any other medium they excel in. Criteria used for scoring the talent: skill and stage presence, expression throughout and self-confidence.

IMPROMPTU QUESTION 1-20 points

Each contestant appears on-stage in formal wear. Each contestant will be given a question drawn at random. Criteria used for scoring the impromptu question: stage presence, composure, clarity of voice, speaking skills and expression.

PERSONALITY 1-15 points

This is very IMPORTANT be courteous to everyone! The congeniality is far more coveted than the crown itself. The judges could be watching you at all times, so keep a positive attitude through the whole pageant.

POISE / APPEARANCE 1-15 points

Each contestant will be viewed throughout the day by the judges. This area is very important, as it will give the general public the first impression of our current queen as she is presented at public events. Criteria used for scoring the appearance/personality: make-up, hairstyle, grooming, appearance in business attire and formal wear and congeniality/personality.

CONTESTANT F. Y. I

INTERVIEW - When being asked questions, honesty, sincerity and simplicity are the key. Judges look for contestants who are confident and comfortable with their questions.

TALENTS – Vocal - remember to choose a song you can sing comfortably. Poetry – choose a monologue that fits you and your expression. Instrumentalists – choose your material wisely. Dance – area 10' x 12' plan accordingly.

SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENT - There really isn't much that can be said about this area, only remember it all has to do with your achievements in church, school and community.

APPLICATION – Make sure your application is typed. Your applications will be viewed by the judges and this is their first impression of you. Have someone you know proofread your work. Keep a copy of your application and make sure you know everything on it because chances are you will be asked questions directly from your application. Make sure you follow the directions given. This is very important as you can be marked down in points. Make sure to return your application by the deadline.

IMPROMPTU QUESTION - This is probably the one area that can break any ties between contestants. You must have confidence when answering the question. All I can say is to be prepared for anything. Always remember the following: composure, posture, clarity of expression, clarity of voice (your speaking skills) and most of all SMILE.

PERSONALITY / POISE / APPEARANCE – It is IMPORTANT to be courteous to everyone. The judges could be watching you at all times, so keep a positive attitude through the whole pageant. It's best to be yourself. DON'T OVER-DO.

NOTE: During the Pageant, please keep the following in mind:

1. There is a pageant for everyone.
2. Quitters and bad attitudes will never win.
3. Everyone has bad days.
4. Persistence and dedication make winners.
5. Poise and confidence is the key to the crown.
6. Practice your smile for the next pageant.

2021 MISS GENESEE COUNTY FAIR QUEEN PAGEANT GUIDELINES

- 1) **ALL COMPLETED APPLICATIONS ARE TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE FAIR OFFICE BY FRIDAY, JULY 2, 2021. POSTMARKED BY MIDNIGHT ON THIS DATE. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 2) Contestants must be between the ages of 15 years to 21 years old (age as of January 1st of the current year), never been married, never had children, and a resident of Genesee County. A currently reigning Genesee County Fair Queen may not run the year following her crowning.
- 3) The Contest will be held on Saturday, August 21, check-in and judging to be determined. .
- 4) Contestants agree to:
 - (1) be personally interviewed by the judges in a business attire
 - (2) appear on stage in a formal/evening gown for judging
 - (3) answer a "fishbowl" question on stage
- 5) Contestants agree that the decision of the judges shall be final.
- 6) Contestants agree to abide by all rules of the Genesee County Fair now in effect or hereafter announced.
- 7) Not compete in any other judged pageant during her reign as Miss Genesee County Fair Queen.
- 8) Judging will be based on the following point system: Application-10 pts., Scholastic Achievement-10 pts., Interview-20 pts., Talent-10 pts., Impromptu Question-20 pts., Personality-15 pts., Poise / Appearance-15 pts..
- 9) Must be available on Saturday, August 21, 2021, 2PM-8PM, AND Monday, August 23, 2021, 5PM-8PM. The exact schedule for check-in and judging will be available ten days prior to the Pageant. Parade will take place at 5PM. Coronation will take place at 7PM. All contestants must be present at the Parade and Coronation Ceremony.
- 10) The winner will reign for one year. The Queen and Her Court must be available during the week of August 23-29, 2021 to host Fair activities (at least 4 hours per day). Throughout the year the Queen and her Court will be asked to participate in local parades or host additional activities.
- 11) Order of Judging: Interview (business attire), Talent (bring everything that is necessary), On-Stage Question (formal wear). Totaling of all scores and the announcement of Queen, 1st and 2nd Runners-up and Coronation will be announced to the general public at 7PM on Monday, August 23, 2021, in the Grandstand Area.
- 12) Must file your pageant application with the Genesee County Fair Office, along with a photo (that may be used in print materials to promote the contest).
- 13) If the Queen, 1st or 2nd runners-up are unable to fulfill their duties, due to circumstances found to be objectionable by the Genesee County Fair Board of Directors, they will forfeit all awards. Queen – Crown and Sash, 1st and 2nd runner-up – sash. The next in line will finish their reign.
- 14) No scores will be released to any contestant.
- 15) **It is mandatory that you send the application, photo of yourself, and entry fee.** All submitted material must be **typed**. Photo used for identification purposes and may be used to promote the contest. If photo is not with application you will not be qualified to participate in the 2021 Miss Genesee County Fair Queen Pageant.
- 16) All materials (application and photo, etc) become the property of the Genesee County Fair.
- 17) Genesee County Fair Executive Director reserves the right to modify these Rules and Policies at any time, and with or without cause or notice.
